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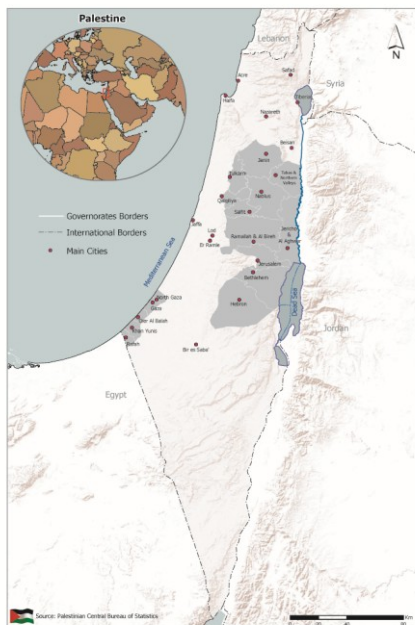

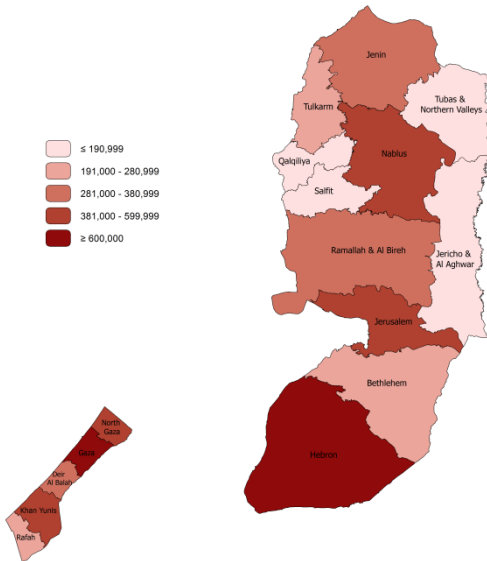

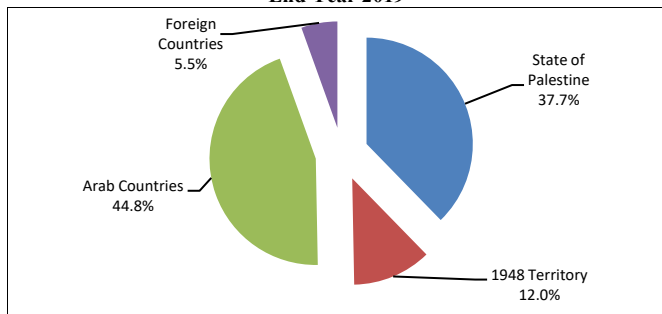
Estimated Population in Palestine by Governorate, (Mid-Year 2019)

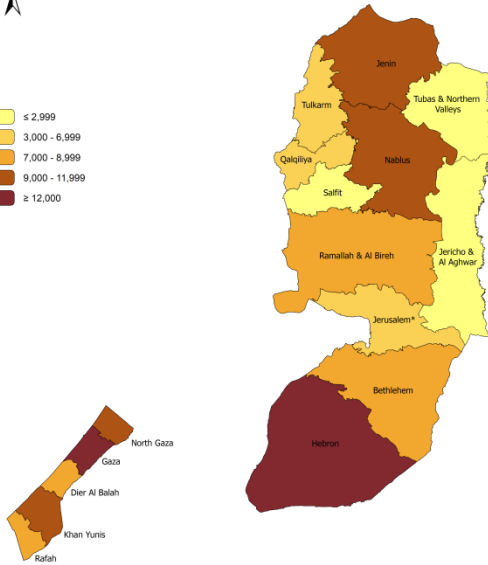
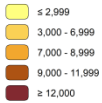

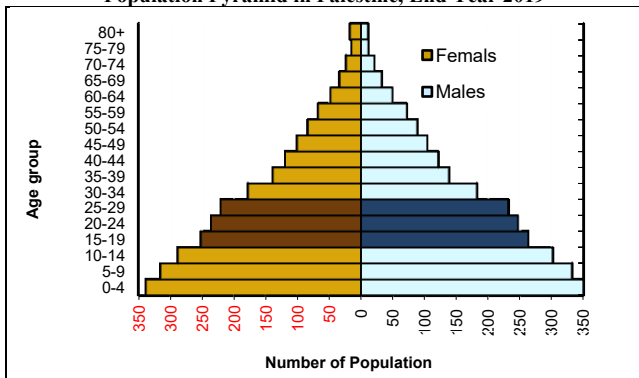

Registered Live Births in Palestine by Governorate, 2018

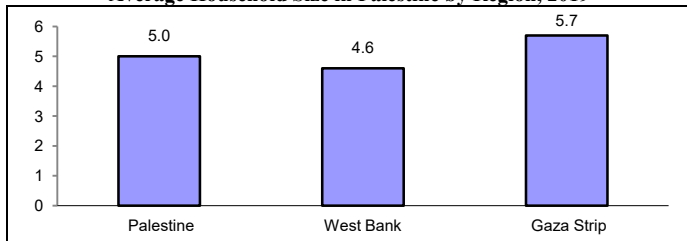

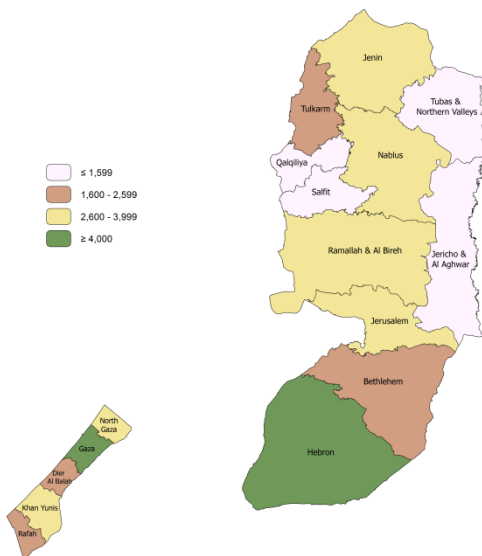

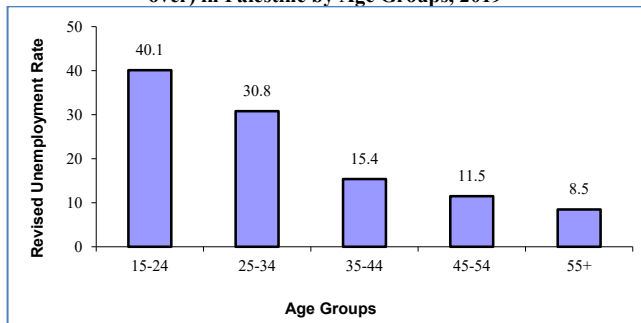

## Revised Unemployment Rate of Participants in Labour Force (15 Years and over) in Palestine by Age Groups, 2019

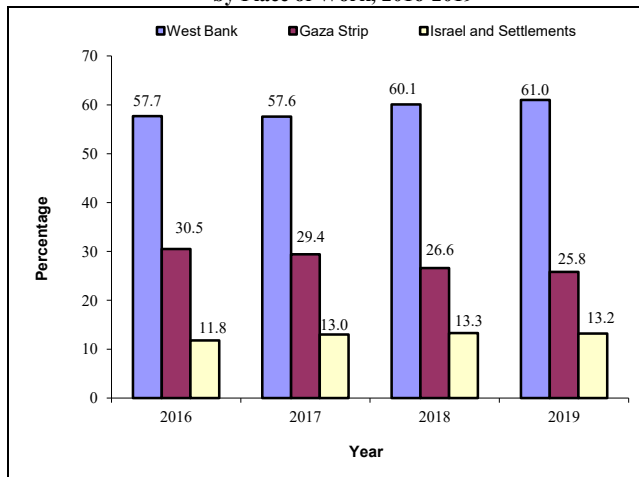

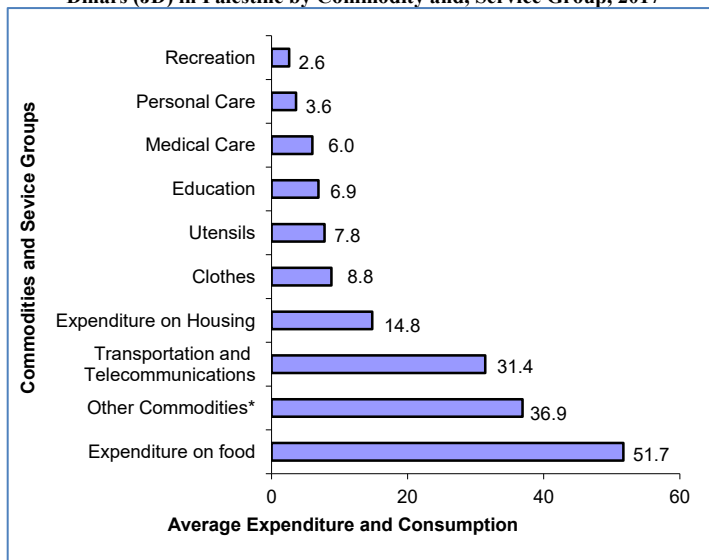

**Average Monthly Per Capita Expenditure and Consumption in Jordanian Dinars (JD) in Palestine by Commodity and, Service Group, 2017**

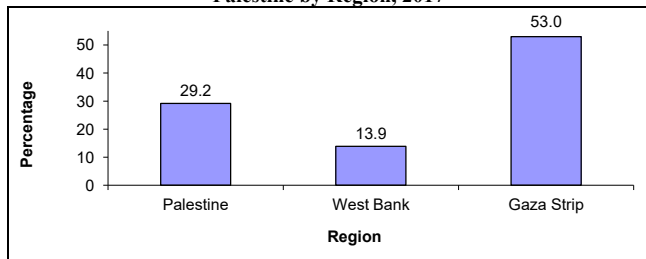

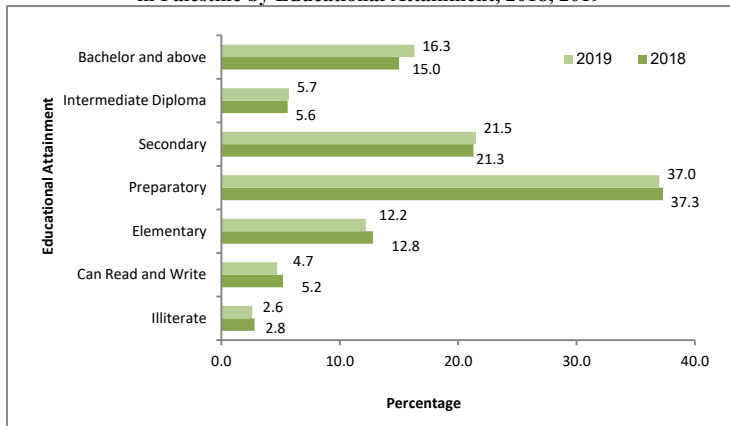

### Percentage Distribution of Persons aged (15 Years and over) in Palestine by Educational Attainment, 2018, 2019

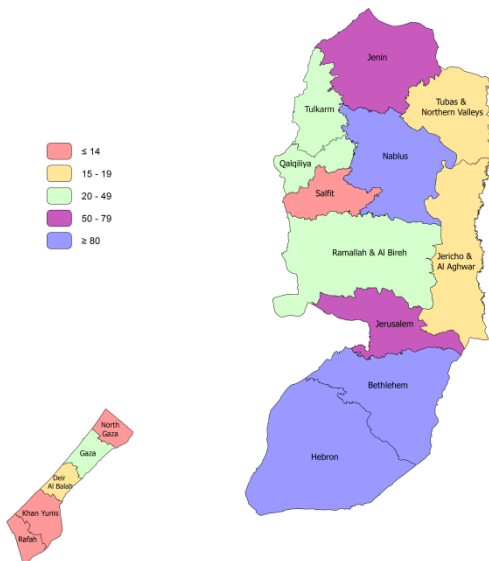

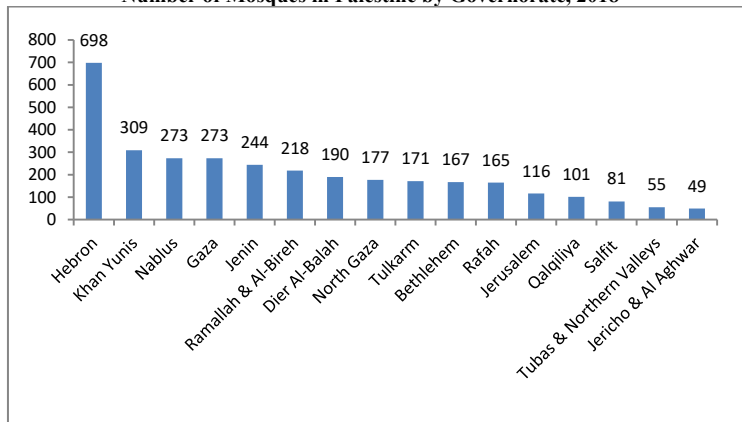

**Number of Mosques in Palestine by Governorate, 2018**



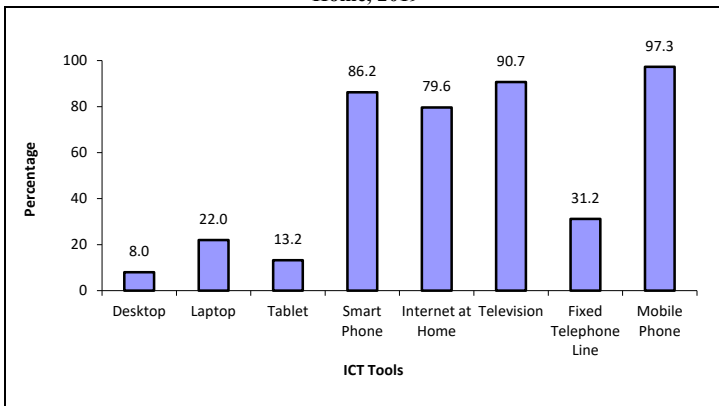

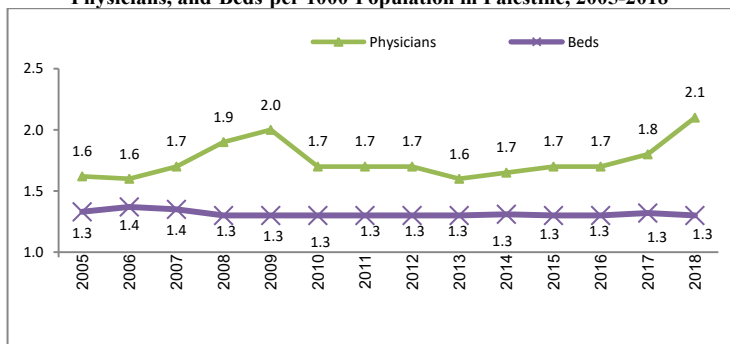

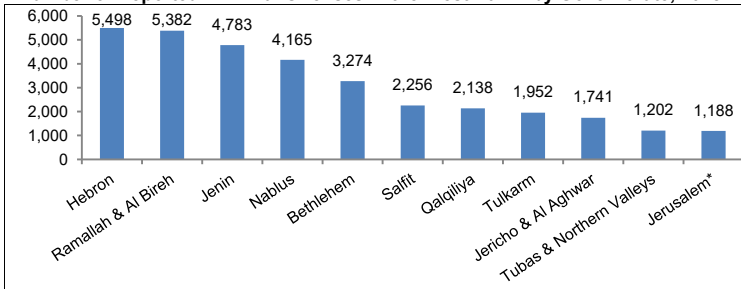

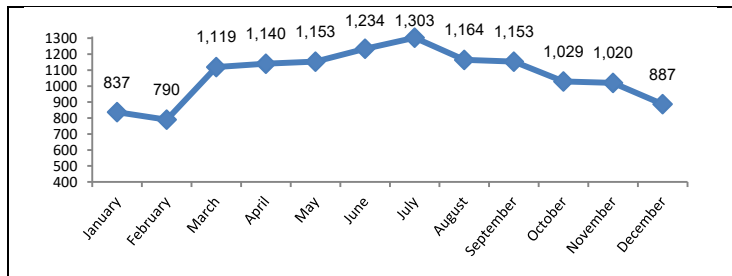

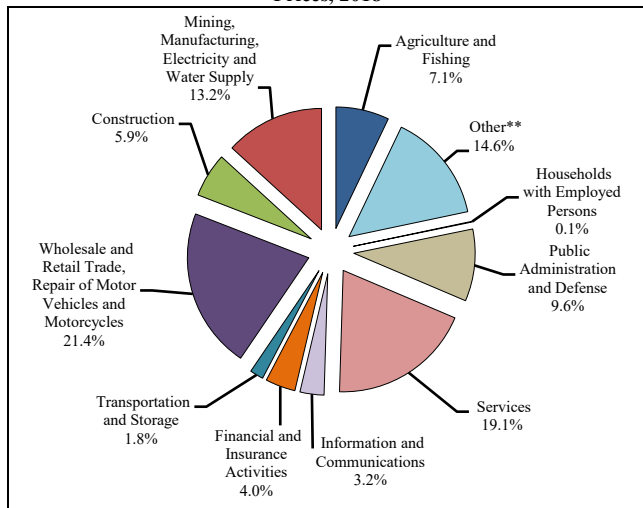

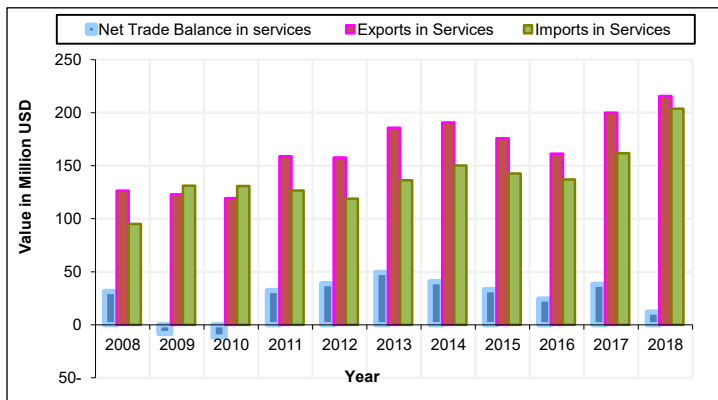

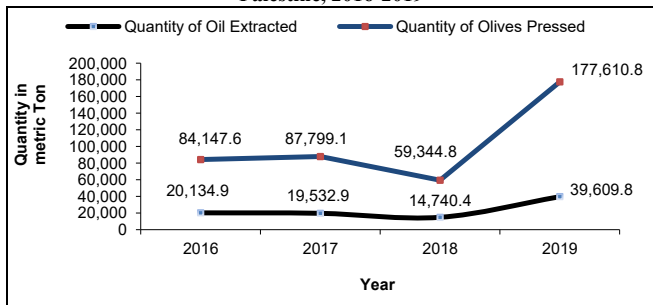

### Quantity of Olives Pressed and Olive Oil Extracted in Palestine, 2016-2019



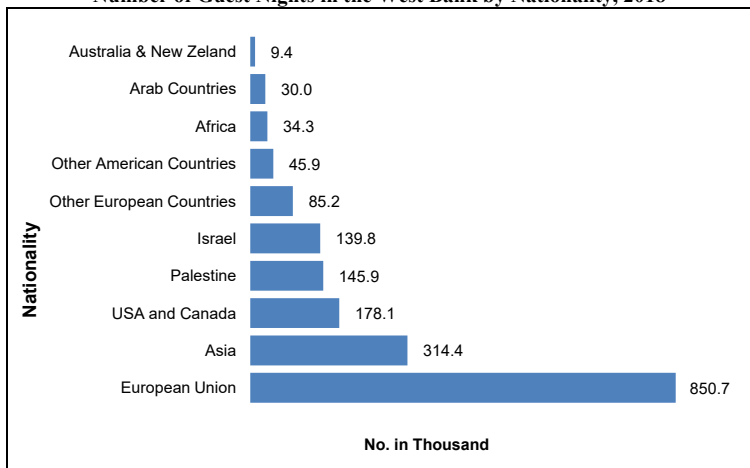

### Number of Guest Nights in the West Bank by Nationality, 2018

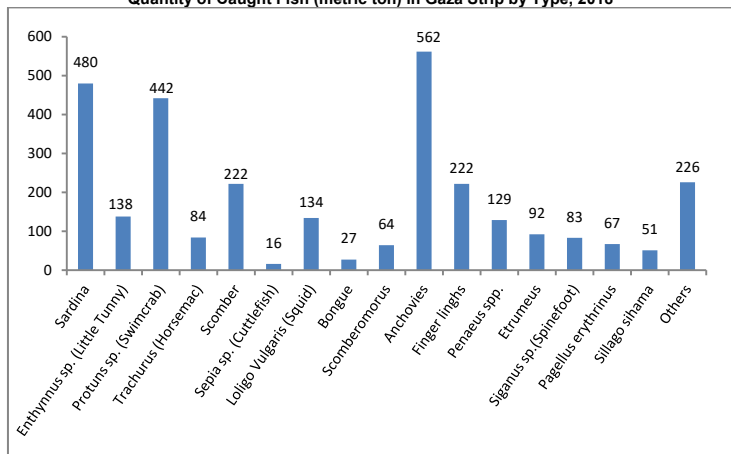

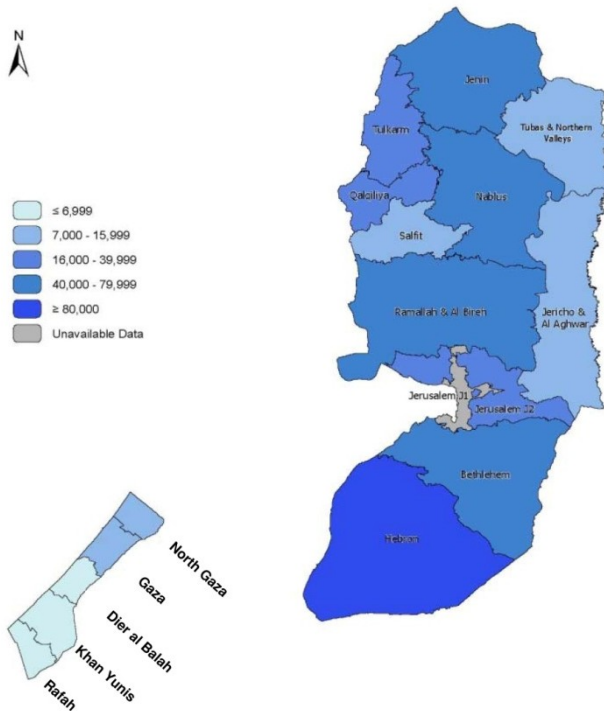

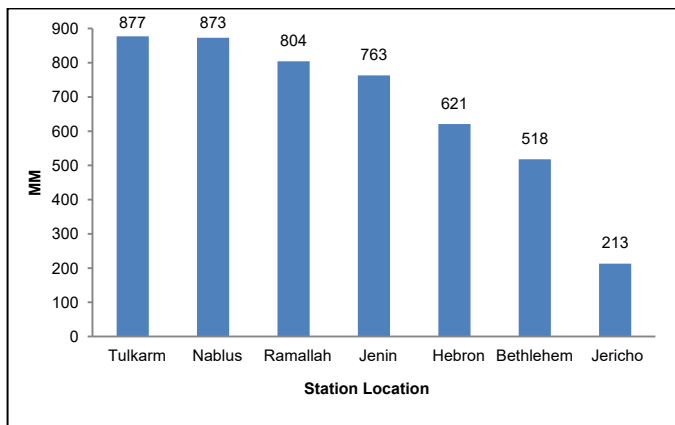

### Quantity of Water Available Annually in Palestine, 2009-2018

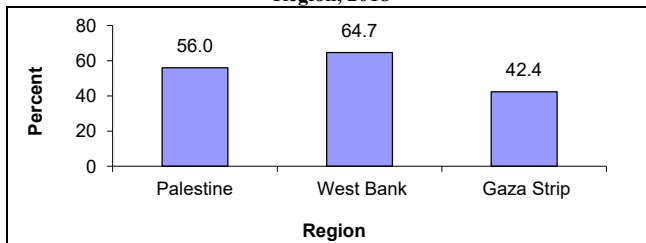

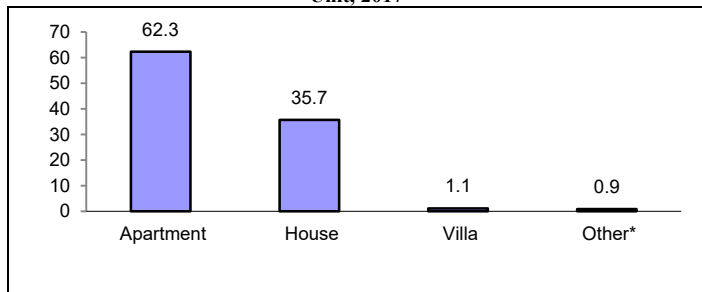
